The project includes the renovation, extension and upgrading of six buildings that make up the former military complex dating back to 1900. Total area surface is 21,000 m². Reconstruction was needed to improve the seismic behavior and different purpose for brick buildings and the extension in order to provide enough space for all the activities. Thus, are in the brick building located concrete cores. New buildings located on the atrial side of old buildings have a diversified system of steel and concrete structures. The main concrete building system provides stability, while an additional steel structure holds the large canopies and facade. Parking spaces will be situated in two subterranean garage floors in the atrium of the complex. The refurbished buildings (21,000 m²) will host: National Museum (1 building), Ethnographic Museum (2 buildings), Museum of Modern Art (1 building), non-institutional culture (1 building) and the Department for Protection of Natural and Cultural Heritage (1 building) .
